The role of the team co-ordinator

- May be asked to help us secure permissions with the hospital for your team visit. If needed, this will be fully explained.
- Decides on the time of the visit, in conjunction with the hospital liaison.
- Creates a community space for team members to plan their Mother's Day Connect visit (we recommend a WhatsApp group)
- Welcomes new team members, sent via Embrace sign ups, to the team community.
- Acts as the communication liaison between the Embrace hub and your team members.
- Facilitates the team discussion on what gift/treat the team will organise and bring the nurses and new mothers.
- Keeps the team members encouraged in the lead up.

On the day

- Arrives at the hospital 15 minutes before the team to meet the staff/ hospital liaison
- Meets team members at the agreed meeting point
- Assists the team with navigating the ward/ wards, as directed by the hospital staff
- Thanks the staff for hosting .
- Sends necessary feed back and images to the Embrace Hub.
